We learned a lot today! Great idea, PCP Bob!

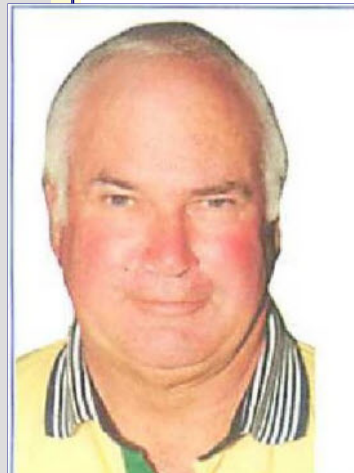
